- P: <sup>13</sup>As a father has compassion for his children, so the LORD has compassion for those who fear him.
- C: <sup>14</sup>For he knows how we were made; he remembers that we are dust.
- P: <sup>15</sup>As for mortals, their days are like grass; they flourish like a flower of the field;
- C: <sup>16</sup>for the wind passes over it, and it is gone, and its place knows it no more.
- P: <sup>17</sup>But the steadfast love of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting

on those who fear him, and his righteousness to children's children,

C: <sup>18</sup>to those who keep his covenant and remember to do his commandments.

## Philippians 2:3-4

<sup>3</sup>Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility regard others as better than yourselves. <sup>4</sup>Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others.

#### 2 Corinthians 5:6-10

<sup>6</sup>So we are always confident; even though we know that while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord — <sup>7</sup>for we walk by faith, not by sight. <sup>8</sup>Yes, we do have confidence, and we would rather be away from the body and at home with the Lord. <sup>9</sup>So whether we are at home or away, we make it our aim to please him. <sup>10</sup>For all of us must appear before the judgment seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense for what has been done in the body, whether good or evil.

#### Gospel: Mark 14:3-9

<sup>3</sup>While he was at Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at the table, a woman came with an alabaster jar of very costly ointment of nard, and she broke open the jar and poured the ointment on his head. <sup>4</sup>But some were there who said to one another in anger, "Why was the ointment wasted in this way? <sup>5</sup>For this ointment could have been sold for more than three hundred denarii, and the money given to the poor." And they scolded her. <sup>6</sup>But Jesus said, "Let her alone; why do you trouble her? She has performed a good service for me. <sup>7</sup>For you always have the poor with you, and you can show kindness to them whenever you wish; but you will not always have me. <sup>8</sup>She has done what she could; she has anointed my body beforehand for its burial. <sup>9</sup>Truly I tell you, wherever the good news is proclaimed in the whole world, what she has done will be told in remembrance of her."
