

Mrs. Davidson's Class

I'm back! We had a very nice time visiting and enjoying some family time in California. Thank you to Mrs. DePaula for covering the class for the week!

Teacher Martha's Class

We started our new unit this week called Wonderfully Made. The kids have enjoyed learning about how we grow. The kids are always ready to grow up and they worry about how tall they are. Next week we will begin to discover and learn about the different parts of our bodies. We will also be learning how different insects and animals are from us. It will be a fun week full of discovery of how God made our bodies.

We practiced our addition this week. The kids were chatting and making up numbers so just for fun, we added 2 digit numbers. The kids did very well and we very excited to learn they can do "big kid" math. We are working on simple single digit addition. Find things at home for them to practice counting and adding.

In Bible, we began the story of Daniel. We talked about how he always prayed and asked for God to help him make good choices. The kids made a door hanger and I was so pleased to hear them all talk about how they were going to use it as a reminder to pray for their good choices and their friends good choices for the day.

This week we are discussing how becoming friends with Jesus changed Zacchaeus' heart. He had been greedy and unkind when he collected taxes. Taking more than he was supposed to. After spending time with Jesus, his heart was softened, and he returned anything he had taken time 4. Great opportunity to include mathematical concepts.

This week we worked on a letter scavenger hunt with letter coins, then matched the letter to the items on the alphabet chart as well as patterns and number recognition, seeing how various angles make the cars go faster and farther. Blending primary colors to create any color we want. Some used bubble wrap, others paint brushes. There is always the favorite, fingers!!!

With the nicer weather, we have been able to get outside. The fresh air and unstructured play time is so essential to child development. Not to mention, using pent up energy.
