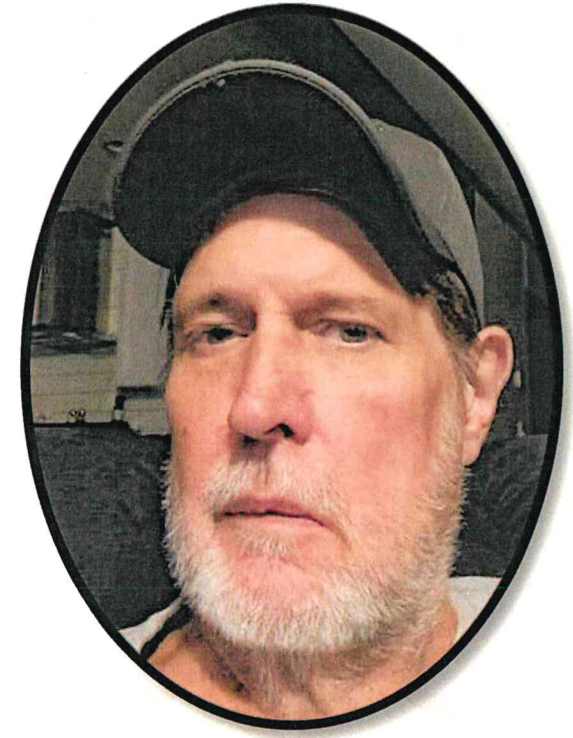


23rd Psalm
