PFE Scholarship Grants Available!!!

Partnering for Eternity (PFE) is a scholarship grant program designed to encourage student involvement in service and in forming relationships with older adults while providing funds for tuition assistance. Students visit with older adults weekly with their parents and perform companion activities (reading, going for walks, etc.) or chore activities (yard work, helping prepare meals, etc).



For each weekly hour-long, parent supervised visit a student receives \$25.00 credit to their bill. Students can earn up to \$100-\$125 a month for their school bill!
