Currently at the ABC, he has been a journalist, sports commentator and television presenter for more than a decade in conjunction with running an athlete media training company. As an experienced broadcaster, journalist and producer, he is an accomplished interviewer and storyteller. These skills will significantly aid Squash Australia TV content and will help produce the best squash stories through both mainstream and digital media.

Squash Australia has placed an emphasis on the importance of a strong media strategy to ensure Squash Australia has a strong brand with engaging content that both connects with the traditional squash audience, but also brings new viewers to the sport. Scott brings strong contacts within Australian sport and good relationships with those in sport media, having worked on major sporting events, including covering the London Olympics, British Open golf championships, Formula One Grand Prix events and the Sydney to Hobart yacht race.

He is also currently working with athletes across a variety of sports, including the major football codes, tailoring training programs for each individual to enable the athlete to perform in the media and during meetings with sponsors.

Traditional media is rapidly facing competition from the digital world, so we required a person who has meet the challenge of this change. Scott has played an active role in this change at the ABC. He has trained journalists and athletes in social media best practice and is experienced at controlling the conversation on these platforms, whilst also creating content designed for digital and mobile platforms.

He holds tertiary qualifications, including a Bachelor of Communications (major in journalism) and is completing a Master of Business Administration (majoring in sport management).
