

Outdoor Worship at Chula Vista SDA

Requirements

No size limits, but 6 feet social distancing is still required

Masks are required outdoors where 6 feet distancing cannot be maintained

Sanitization is still required along with screening

Voted Recommendations

1. Masks are required until you sit down

2. Then you can remove masks

3. If you have to get up and leave your seat please put your mask on

Singing is allowed outdoors, but still has risks. We are recommending to sing outdoors.

One Mic per person speaking or singing on platform

Screening:

1. We only do a verbal screening. Do you have any symptoms of COVID-19?

2. There won't be any thermometer checks for outdoor service

3. We will take several photos of the audience to see who attended.

What Worship will look like?

We will still be keeping our service to about an hour

Singing will be included, but limited (Opening hymn, Closing hymn, and special music).

We will be opening the restrooms in the fellowship hall.

We will have plenty of water and canopies for shade

We still won't have children's story, but try to incorporate cubs corner when we have it.

It will be hot

Church Flow

Cars will come in and park in the asphalt parking lots in available stalls

We will have a welcome table at the entrance of the dirt lot with a 10x10 canopy for masks, Sabbath School Quarterlies, water and more

We will ask if you have any COVID-19 symptoms (Verbal screening only)

You can bring your own comfy chairs or chair covers for the metal seats.

We will provide a stack of sanitized metal chairs that you can use if needed

We will encourage everyone to sit with households and spread out for social distancing.

Once you get to your seat under a canopy, you can remove your mask

Restrooms will be available in the fellowship hall. You will enter through the South Building door and exit through the double doors. We will still be limiting two at a time in each restroom (Men's and Women's)
