

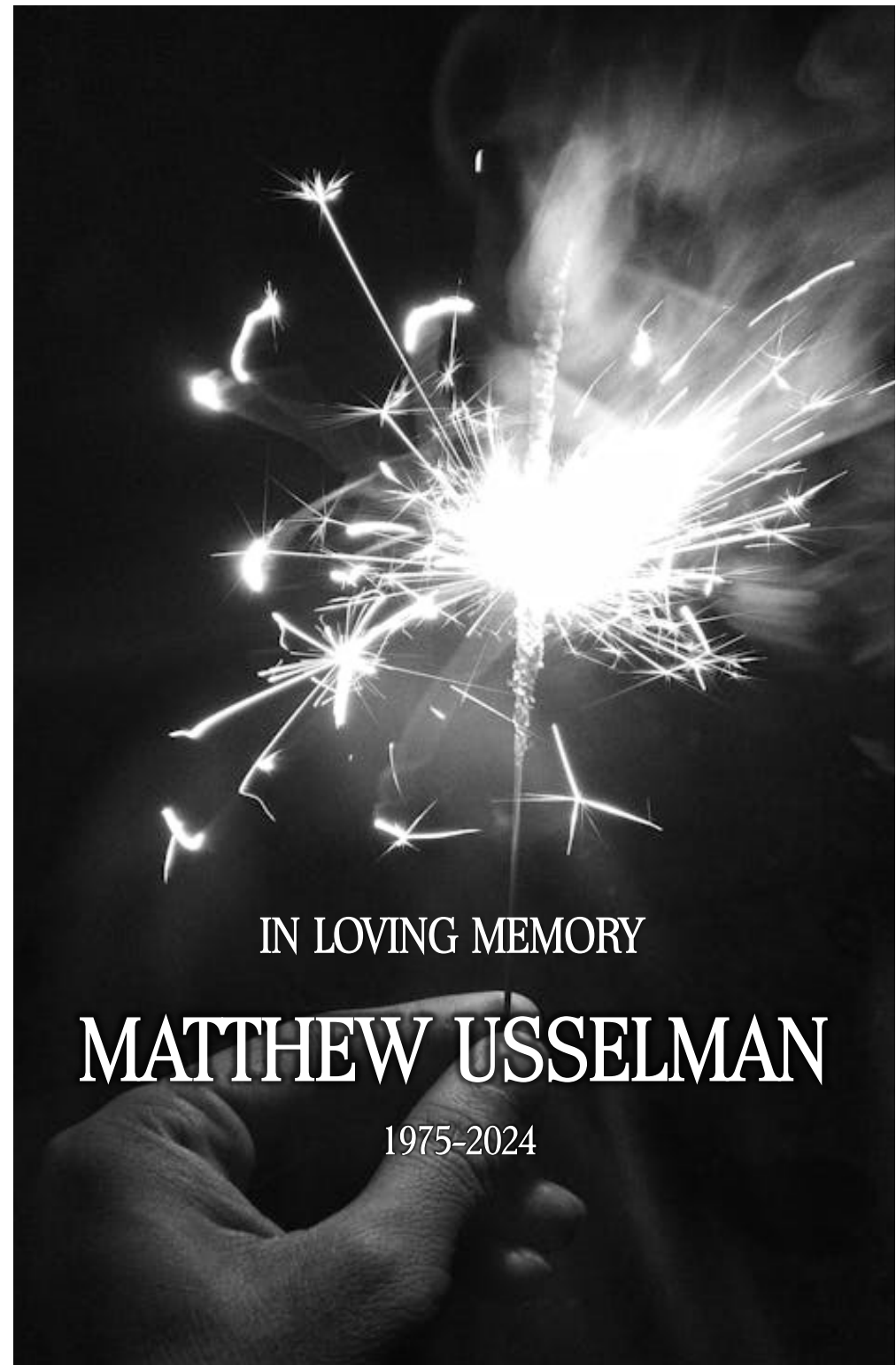
*For those I love
