ATTN MEMBERS: The Church’s heating & air conditioning system failed: one unit was non-functional and the other one was failing due to the added stress. The units were over 34-years old.

Therefore, the Church Board took immediate action to replace the entire heating\air systems; at the cost of \$13,000.00. Unfortunately, because there were not enough maintenance funds immediately available, the Church Board also voted to borrow the money needed from the Adventist Lay Builders Association, for five years at 3.5% interest. Payments will be approx. \$250.00 per month.
