The Obituary

Alfonzo McAfee, was born on May 26, 1932 in Detroit, Michigan.

He attended the Detroit Public Schools System. He graduated from Miller High School class of 1950. After graduating, he joined the United States Marine Corp as an Airplane Dispatch Clerks.
