Charles Ray Ashcraft

January 28, 1943 - May 17, 2021

Charles invented products most of us use daily.

Charles developed the candy bar wrapper used commonly today—an improvement from paper wrappers. This process, patented by his employer, significantly extends the shelf life of candy, while allowing the package to be easily opened.

He designed the alcohol wipes that are used in doctor's offices and hospitals. They were created to help the military medical corps during the Vietnam War so that they no longer had to carry glass bottles of alcohol and cotton swabs. This is the only patent owned by Charles and was a gift from the company.

He was involved in developing sealants used in flexible packaging and determining the temperatures best used to seal them. Our New York friends used to complain to him when they could not tear open their prepared cereal. He always explained that companies did not control the sealing temperature.

Charles developed "flavor burst" to add a scent when you open packages and make the food more appealing, covering up the smell of the packaging and preservatives. This is still used in most snacks and many food products.

Charles also developed handi wipes to be used as a tougher military grade wipe and invented lids, sealant, and improved packaging processes for Crisco, Yoplait yogurt cups, and Gogurt.

His mind worked all night as he sought inspiration in problem solving at work and I would often hear him talking in his sleep about his projects. "Yes that will work. Why didn't I think of that before?" Charles credits the Holy Ghost for his success in his work and in his life.


