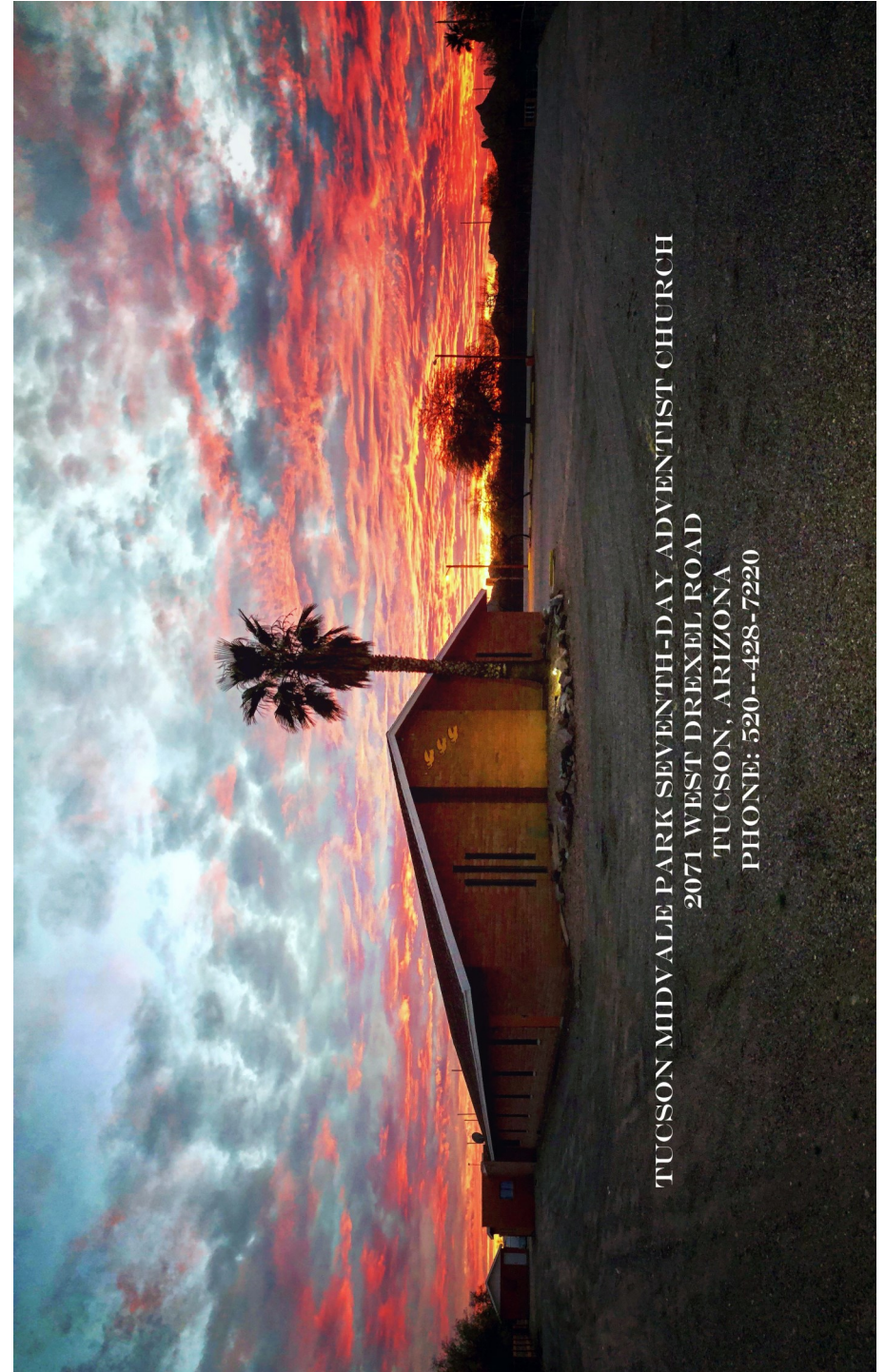
Kitchen: No Potluck
