We're Food4AllCbus, a nonprofit organization working to provide fresh food to our neighbors that face food insecurity.

We do this through community fridges: refrigerators located in a public space, open 24/7, where anyone can take or leave food.

Ribbon Cutting Event

The ribbon-cutting event on December 16th brought together beneficiaries, donors, volunteers, partners, and friends of the Fridge.

We set up a tent and handed out >30 hot beverages and dozens of sweet treats and snacks. Two donors brought food for the fridge and ~10 families left with some food items they needed from the ~40lbs of food in the fridge.

We created partnerships with two local nonprofits and received over 100 lbs of food from them over the winter holidays (December 18th - Jan 1st).

We stocked the fridge 4 times this week, amounting to ~180 lbs of food.

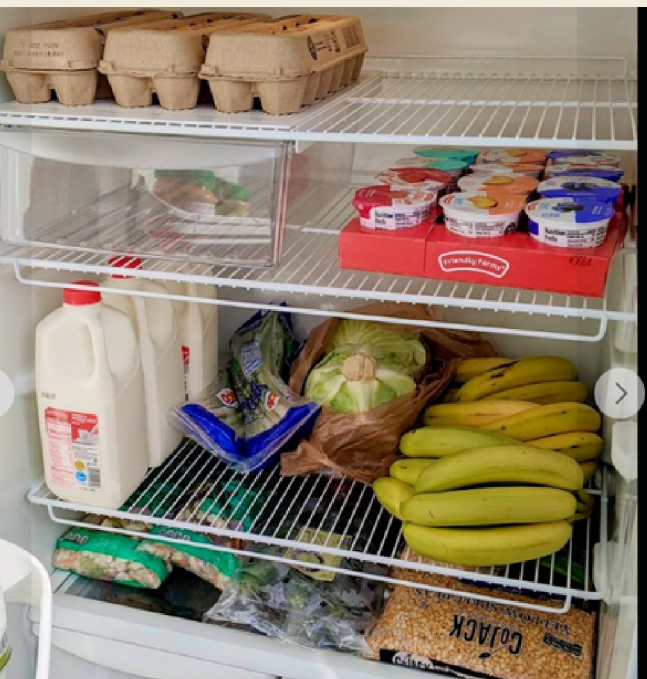

Donor Homecooked Meals

From the two meetings held so far, we received 11 containers of homemade food for the fridge (~10 lbs), with Afghani and Algerian dishes.

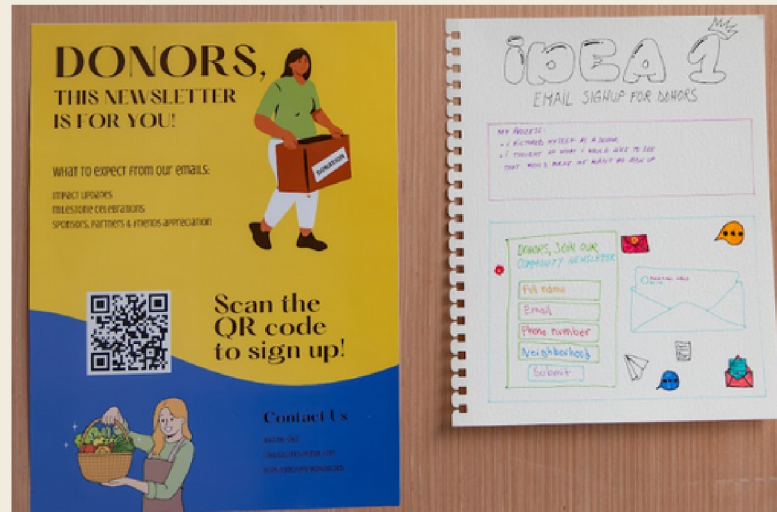
Youth Volunteers

Our kid volunteers were involved at the organization level, as project managers of their own ideas, as well as operational, in creating goodie bags, decorations or cutting up fliers.

Idea 1: Email Signup for Donors

Our Youth Volunteer created the text for the poster and the landing page where the QR code directs.

Interested donors leave their contact information and are added to our newsletter list, where we keep them updated on all things Fridge.



Idea 3: Flyers to spread the word

Our Youth Volunteer created a design for flyers to be spread at the Ribbon-cutting event.

He designed it himself in Canva, with a little help from our board member Megan.



Idea 4: Goodie givebacks for donors

Our youth volunteer proposed a project to show appreciation for donors by sharing goodie bags with messages from the team and beneficiaries.

The team put together 45 goodie bags and placed them in a box inside the fridge.

Financial Transparency

Monetary donations amount to \$4,013.37, made by 5 donors. ChangeX was the largest contributor, with a seed donation of \$3,500.00.

- The ChangeX funding was used for the following purposes:
 - purchase a residential refrigerator
 - purchase materials to build a shed for the fridge
 - prepare informational materials
 - deliver Youth Volunteer projects
 - purchase hot beverages and snacks for the ribbon-cutting event
 - purchase food to stock the fridge
- Funding from other donors was used for the following:
 - articles of incorporation
 - obtaining an EIN number
