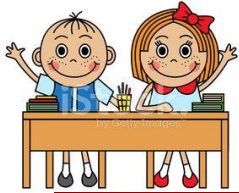

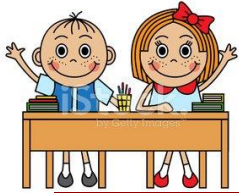


This week in 5/6 grade Bible we have been learning about peace and reading stories from Samuel when

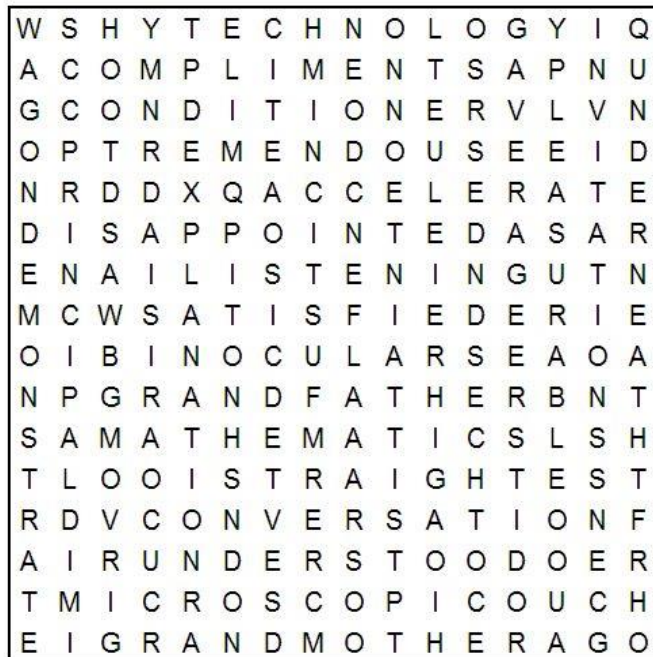
This semester we will be learning about people.
