**Summer office hours** will be as follows: Monday & Wednesday from 10:00-2:00, Tuesday from 1:30-5:30, closed Thursday & Friday. On Monday, August 12, regular office hours begin: Mon.-Thurs. 8:00-4:00 and Fridays 8:00-1:00.

For those of you who are interested in the **Pine Hills Summer Camp program** for grades K-6 you must sign-up this week in the office. We still have some space available. We are asking families to pay at least one week prior to the week that you are requesting services. The weekly rate will be \$175/child for families that pre-register for their desired weeks by May 30<sup>th</sup> and \$200/week for families who sign-up after the May 30<sup>th</sup> deadline. A daily rate is also being made available of \$40/day for families that pre-register for their desired days by May 30<sup>th</sup> and \$50/day for families who sign-up after May 30<sup>th</sup>. There will be a total of seven weeks to choose from, beginning with the week of August 17<sup>th</sup> and ending with the week of August 5<sup>th</sup>, with the exception of the week of July 1<sup>st</sup> (July 1-5) where our school will be closed. This will allow our staff to have some vacation time with their families as well. The program will run each day from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM. Weekly programming will include the following: daily worship/Bible study, weekly trips to the public library & swimming pool, daily reading time, math review, cooking, art, music, games, occasional field trips and more. Please let the office know which weeks your child will be participating in. This program is only being offered as a service to our school families. Payments for each week/ day of service must be paid prior to the week your child will be enrolled.

This summer one of our parents is offering an open gym **Summer Basketball** for incoming 5th-8th grade boys at Pine Hills. They will be doing skill building, games, and scrimmages. It will be Mondays and Wednesdays 6-7:30 pm starting June 17th (closed the first two weeks of July). Any questions please call or text Gary Edlund at (310) 493-1772

**The process for re-registration continues.**

Last Friday, the office staff hand delivered Re-Registration paperwork for your family which is in a white envelope. In order to continue to hold your child’s spot for next year we are asking that a \$100 non-refundable deposit towards your child’s first month’s (August) tuition be paid (most families did this back in March) to the office. In addition, we are requesting the submittal of all completed Re-Registration paperwork before Friday, June 14<sup>th</sup>. Families who meet these expectations will have their child’s spot reserved and will receive an additional \$50 credit (per student) on their first month’s tuition statement in August. After June 14<sup>th</sup>, new students who are on our waiting list will be given the opportunity to register, enabling us to fill vacant spots. Thank you for taking this deadline seriously.

**We want your feedback!** The 2019-2020 school year is coming to a close this week. It is our desire to hear your thoughts about this past year. Our staff works tirelessly to serve our families and their students. We strive to provide a Christ centered and academically rich experience for your child. Sometimes we hit the mark, and other times we may not. In order for us to continue to improve, it is important for us to hear from you, the parent.
