Limited to 8 students

Wednesday - Art Class - for Grades 5-8 -drawing/painting
Limited to 10 students

Thurs. - Art Class - for Grades K-4, drawing (K-2) and painting (3-4th)
Limited to 10 students

*Classes will fill on a first come, first served basis.
Students will be considered enrolled in class when
payment has been made and class has been chosen.
