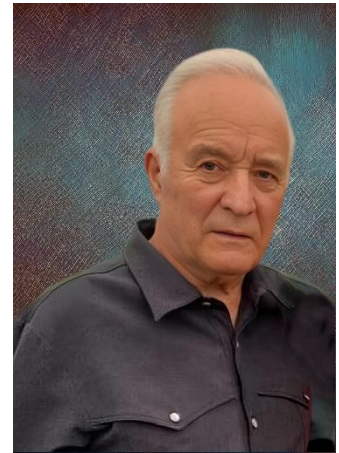


James “St. James” Jeanquart
