Fourth Sabbath Singing Ministry is 2:30 p.m. at Avamere in Cascade Park (just a few blocks south of Mill Plain).



<u>Nursing Room</u> for mothers to feed and change their babies. To give these babies and mothers quiet privacy, no men are allowed. Changing tables are also available in the men's restroom.

Training Chapel is an option for parents with fussy children during church, and is located in the Adult I classroom. Quiet books/toys are available at the front of this area. Parents appreciate having the service live streamed into this room.

Having trouble hearing the service? We can help. Ask a greeter or deacon to point out someone who can help you with one of our audio assisting devices.
