Full squash to return on Monday - what you need to know

Hi Adrian,

It's official! We're excited to announce that from Monday 17 May, you can play full court squash with different households. This means you can play multiple households without having to form a squash bubble or play modified versions.

What can we play?

- Adults and juniors from different households can play full court squash e.g best of five games with tie breaks, and singles and doubles.
- Up to four adults or juniors can get on court at any time allowing for doubles.

Do I have to follow any safety protocols?

Yes. You must continue to observe current UK Government advice on COVID-19 for your own health and safety, and everyone at your club/venue. Key things to remember are:

- Maintain social distancing off court.
- Wear a face covering off court.
- Wash your hands before and after you play.

Below are some further guidelines that you must follow to keep you and fellow players safe:

RETURNING TO COURT

GUIDELINES FOR PLAYING SAFELY



Up to four adults or children from multiple households are allowed on court at any time (except for coach-led activity).



Protective eyewear is strongly recommended at all times.



Take your bag on court with you – lockers and changing rooms may be closed.



Play normal squash (e.g best-of-five games with tie-breaks).



Bring your own racket and balls – disinfect them frequently.



Wash your hands before and after you play.



Don't wipe your hands on the court walls or raise your voice.



Displaying symptoms? Stay at home and follow Government guidance.



Scan your club/venue's NHS QR code using the NHS Test and Trace app.

Returning to your club/venue

Due to the UK Government restrictions still in place including social distancing, your club/venue will still need to implement safety protocols based on our <u>Back to Squash</u> <u>quidelines</u>.

Please be patient with your club/venue as they implement these procedures. <u>Get in touch</u> with them directly to find out if and when they will reopen and what their rules are, including booking procedures.

Let's work together

We need to work together to keep squash safe and our clubs and venues open. It's important that we all follow the latest guidance to reduce the risk of COVID-19.
