Rev. Alan writes... Much of our focus is on the Kingdom of God at the moment. In my talk at last Sunday's 6.30pm parishwide service I spoke about the time we now live in. It is an 'in-between' time between the ascension of Jesus to heaven and a time when he will return and all will be made new. You can watch it on our YouTube channel.

We look forward to that time when will have perfect resurrected bodies, when there will be no pain or suffering, or darkness, the light will be the glory of Christ! But in the meantime there is pain - my family is working through the grief of losing Cobey, our beloved Labrador who died suddenly last weekend after a seizure. It is a stark reminder of the fallen and at times painful world we live in. But the message of the kingdom is not just one of hope for the future when Jesus returns, it is also a message of hope for today. In the middle of our pain the Holy Spirit is close by, ministering to us. And God call us to be agents, playing our part in bringing signs of his future kingdom to the here and now. The parables of Jesus recorded in Matthew's Gospel teach us how to live during this in-between, that's why we calling our Sunday morning Lent series Kingdom Stories.

This Sunday at our 6.30pm parish-wide service we launch a new 9-week series looking at the whole of the book of Philippians. We're calling it *Discovering New Joy*. Paul the apostle discovered the "secret" of true joy and wrote about it in this letter to the church at Philippi. What makes this letter so fascinating is not just his words of encourage-



ment, but the environment in which he wrote them. Paul wrote it in the confines of a prison cell which could have signalled the end of his life on earth. He not only found great joy in these circumstances, but also in a church that had gone to great lengths to demonstrate the gospel with their own lives. I would love you to join us on this journey through Philippians.
