Too Much Drama???

Is your child challenged with social skills? Does s/he have difficulty self-regulating (managing emotions)? This is becoming increasingly common among children and often leads to difficulty functioning in class and maintaining healthy friendships. Since we are observing this so often, we looked for some resources and found that the Syracuse University Psychological Services Center may offer a social skills group for children ages 7-12 for only \$10 per session. The program usually runs for 6 weeks. They are not currently running a group but may do so in the fall and are starting a waitlist of interested families. The focus of the group is to teach kids basic emotion regulation and social skills and helping parents learn how to support their children. To enable this search engine, go to the preferences in your favorite browser-Safari, FireFox, Google, etc. Find the place where you can set the default home page. This is the page that your browser will automatically go to when you open your browser. Copy the following URL and paste it into the Home page/Default page slot:

<https://www.goodsearch.org/> . When you refresh your browser, you will land on the GOODSEARCH page.

Then, in the upper right-hand corner, you will see a place to sign up. Follow the instructions. At some point, you will be asked to choose the charity which will receive their donation. After that, it is automatic-every time you conduct a search, you will be helping PJA in a small way. Thank you!
