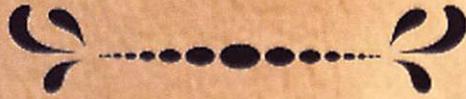

OBITUARY



Earnest James Jackson, 76, of Odessa, Texas, passed away on September 25, 2023 in Odessa, Texas. Mr. Jackson was born in Dallas, Texas to Enorse Jackson and Bennett Williams on December 28, 1946. He went to school in Groesbeck, Texas. Upon graduating, he valiantly served our country in the Army Reserves.
