

1 Corinthians 15:21-22



David Jr. was also known to have a very hearty appetite and enjoyed food very much. It was a blessing that his mom was also a very good cook.

David Jr. attended Elwyn Davidson school for a good portion of his early years until he was 19 years old. After this he attended SPARC adult day program and continued to receive services here until he passed.

David leaves to mourn and cherish his memories, his parents, David Sr. and Sandra Garnett his four brothers, Darren, Davon, Devin and Deon (Cierra), along with several nieces and nephews.
