The book of life contains the names of all who have ever entered the service of God. Jesus bade His disciples: ***"Rejoice, because your names are written in heaven."*** **Luke 10:20.** Paul speaks of his faithful fellow workers, ***"whose names are in the book of life."*** **Philippians 4:3.** Daniel, looking down to ***"a time of trouble, such as never was,"*** declares that God's people shall be delivered, ***"everyone that shall be found written in the book."*** And the revelator says that those only shall enter the city of God whose names ***"are written in the Lamb's book of life."*** **Daniel 12:1; Revelation 21:27.**

A book of remembrance" is written before God, in which are recorded the good deeds of ***"them that feared the Lord, and that thought upon His name."*** **Malachi 3:16.** Their words of faith, their acts of love, are registered in heaven. 

IT IS ALL ABOUT PRAYER

We May Approach God in Confidence Through Jesus' Name, cont'd - In the name of Jesus we may come into God's presence with the confidence of a child. No man is needed to act as a mediator. Through Jesus we may open our hearts to God as to one who knows and loves us. - **(Thoughts From the Mount of Blessing, 84.)**

God Will Honor Jesus' Name in Our Prayers—Every promise in the word of God furnishes us with subject matter for prayer, presenting the pledged word of Jehovah as our assurance. Whatever spiritual blessing we need, it is our privilege to claim through Jesus. We may tell the Lord, with the simplicity of a child, exactly what we need. We may state to Him our temporal matters, asking Him for bread and raiment as well as for the bread of life and the robe of Christ's righteousness. Your heavenly Father knows that you have need of all these things, and you are invited to ask Him concerning them. It is through the name of Jesus that every favor is received. God will honor that name, and will supply your necessities from the riches of His liberality. - **(Thoughts From the Mount of Blessing, 133.)**

We must not only pray in Christ's name, but by the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. This explains what is meant when it is said that the Spirit **“maketh intercession for us, with groanings which cannot be uttered.” Romans 8:26.** Such prayer God delights to answer. When with earnestness and intensity we breathe a prayer in the name of Christ, there is in that very intensity a pledge from God that He is about to answer our prayer **“exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think.” Ephesians 3:20.**

Christ has said, **“What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive them, and ye shall have them.” Mark 11:24.** **“Whatsoever ye shall ask in My name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.” John 14:13.** And the beloved John, under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, speaks with great plainness and assurance: **“If we ask anything according to His will, He heareth us: and if we know that He hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of Him.” 1 John 5:14, 15.** Then press your petition to the Father in the name of Jesus. God will honor that name. **(Christ's Object Lessons, 147, 148.)**
