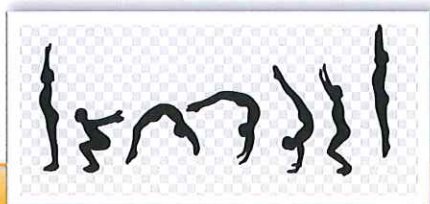
Mount Pisgah Academy Acro-Kids
