Welcome... to all who have come to worship with the Brunswick Seventh-day Adventist Church today. If you are a guest, please check with one of our Greeters for more information on our beliefs and services.

Thank you Mike for speaking today! We appreciate everyone that has been filling in for us—for your willingness, your time, and your messages.

“...in addition to the unity with the apostles, Christ also prayed ‘that they also may be one in us’ (John 17:21). This is a unity with the Father and the Son. It ensures that at all times the Church lives in harmony with the leading of the life-giving Spirit whom the Father and Christ will send (John 14:15, 26; 15:26; 16:7). Unity with the Father and Son means we shall accept the correction of the Spirit and His guidance into all truth (John 16:8-13). This includes the Spirit’s leading through God’s end-time gift of prophecy (Rev. 12:17; 19:10).

Only as Christ followers are ‘in us’ (i.e., with the Father and Son) can they truly ‘be one’ among themselves (John 17: 21). In other words, the horizontal unity (among Christ’s followers) must be grounded in a vertical unity (which is oneness with Christ). We seek unity on this basis so that ‘the world may believe that thou hast sent me’ (verse 21). Jesus declares, ‘I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me’ (verse 23).

In other words, a visible unity results when Christ's followers are in harmony with the apostles and with the Father and Son. This unity is readily evident to the world. It convinces the world of the truthfulness of the Christian message.”
