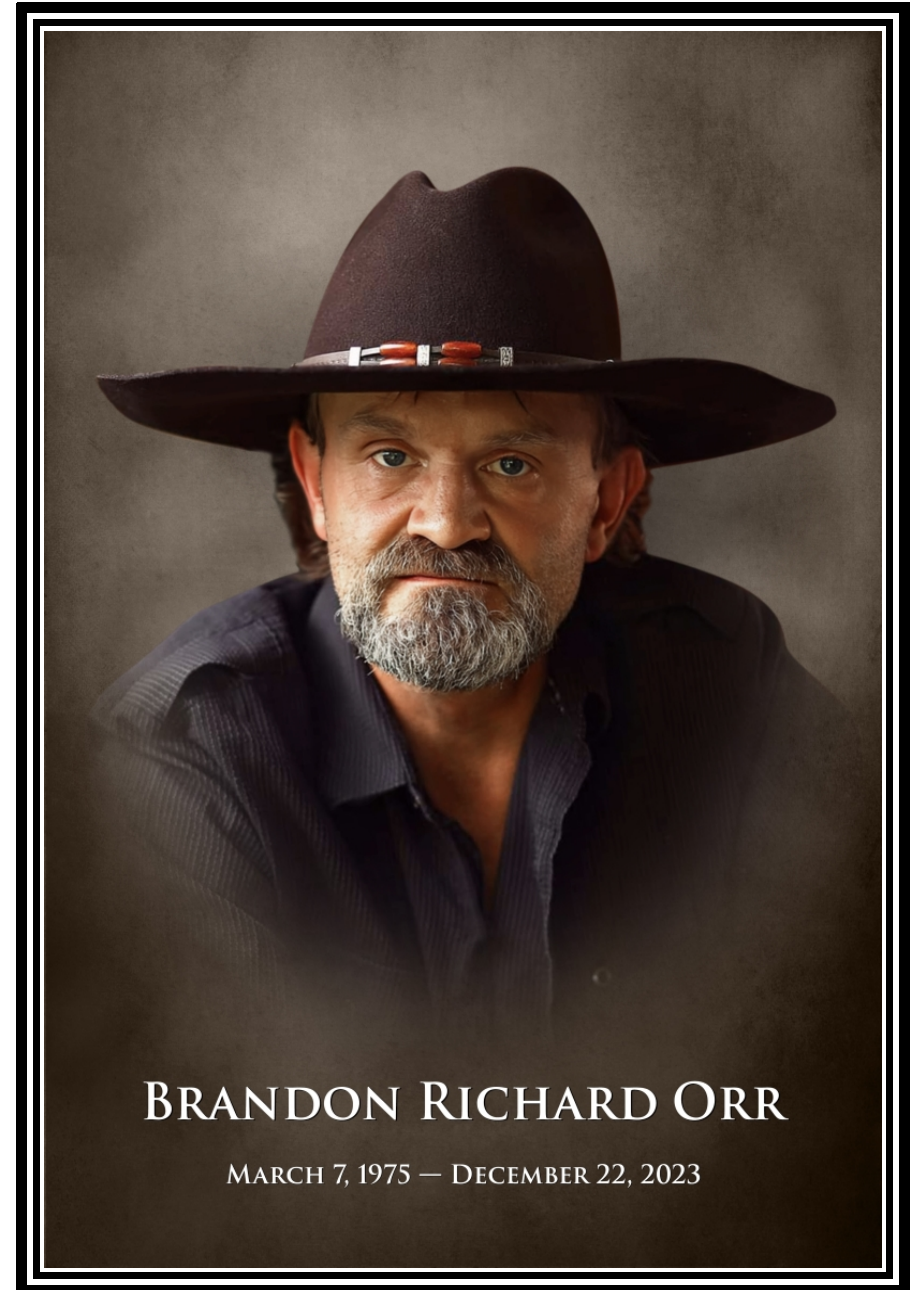
Let Me Go
