DuJuan was born to Glen DuJuan Armstead and Angela Latrice Green on December 22, 1992, in Phoenix, Arizona. Being the only son, DuJuan brought his mother so much joy. At the age of six, DuJuan, his mother, and his grandmother moved to Austin to be back home with their family. He attended school at Winn Elementary, Manor Middle School, and LBJ High School, where he graduated in June of 2011. DuJuan attended Navarro College with a major in Kinesiology.

DuJuan accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior and was baptized at Pleasant Bethany Baptist Church under the leadership of Reverend Don G. Cypress. In May of 2000, he moved his membership to the Pleasant Grove Missionary Baptist Church, where he remained a faithful member until he lost his brave and long battle with autoimmune pancreatitis.

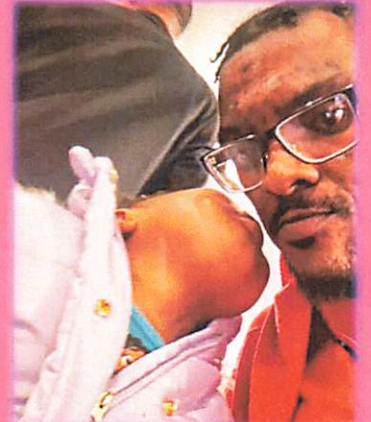
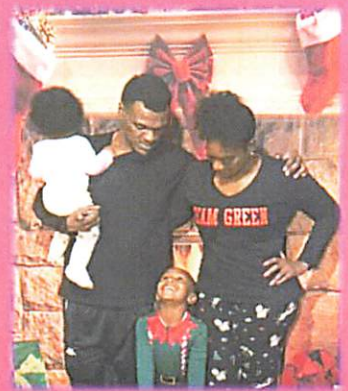
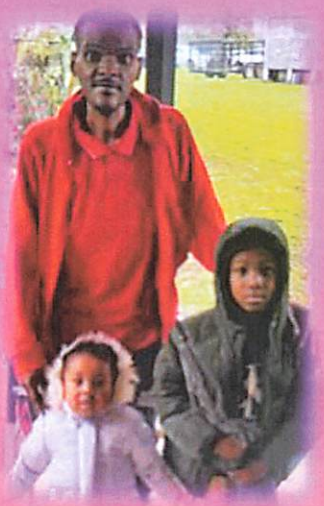
He Only Takes the Best

He only takes “the best”.

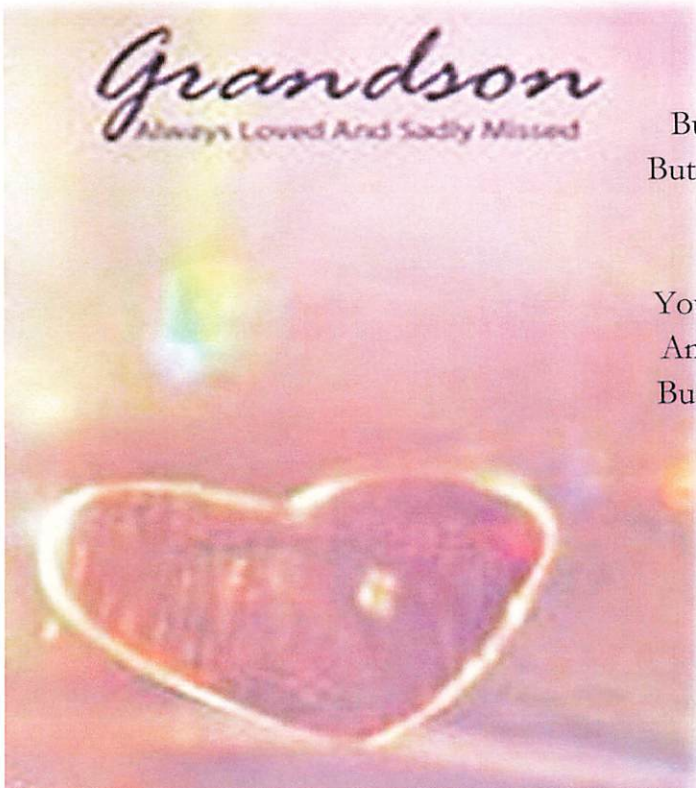
At A Glance
