1. Carrara Squash Centre Opening

The Carrara Squash Centre formally opened its doors on the 22nd of September, held alongside the Australian Club Championships. With the courts successfully having been relocated to the centre as part of the GC2018 Legacy program, the centre is home to a high performance program and will play host to a number of national and world-class events.
