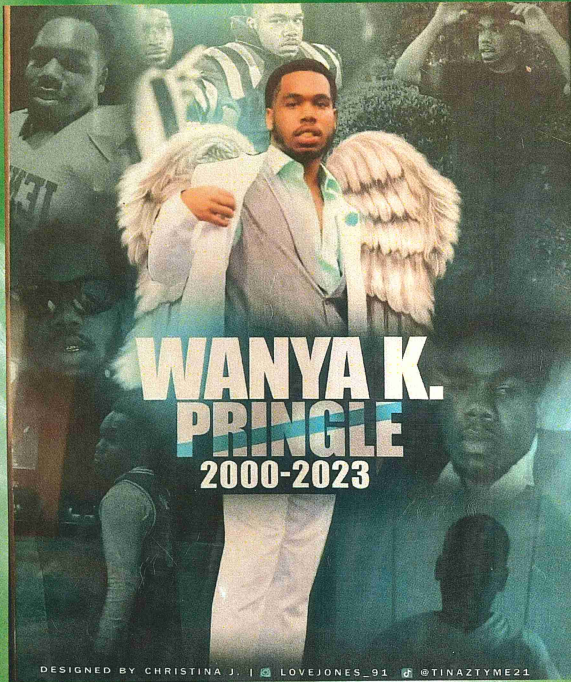

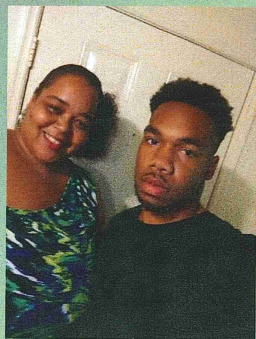
In Loving Memory of My Son
