

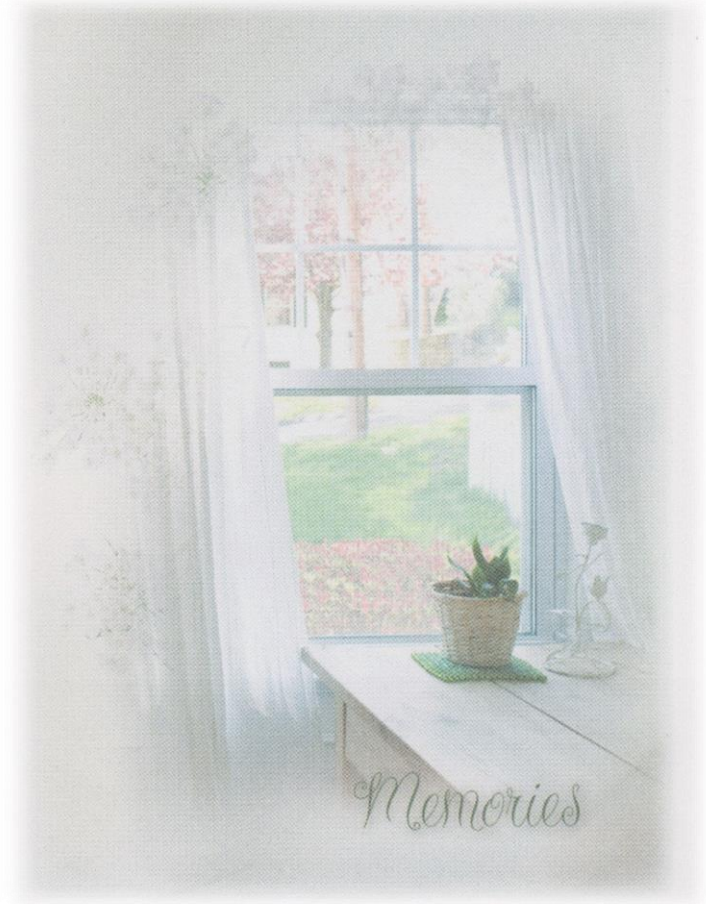
OBITUARY
