In English we are working on a research report. The students are learning the research report process and have chosen a topic, researched, taken notes and have formed an outline of their topic so far.

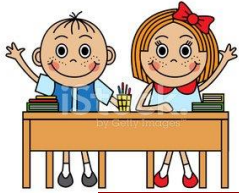
In Science we are studying the Ocean, currents, waves, evaporation, and what causes them.
