they comfort me.

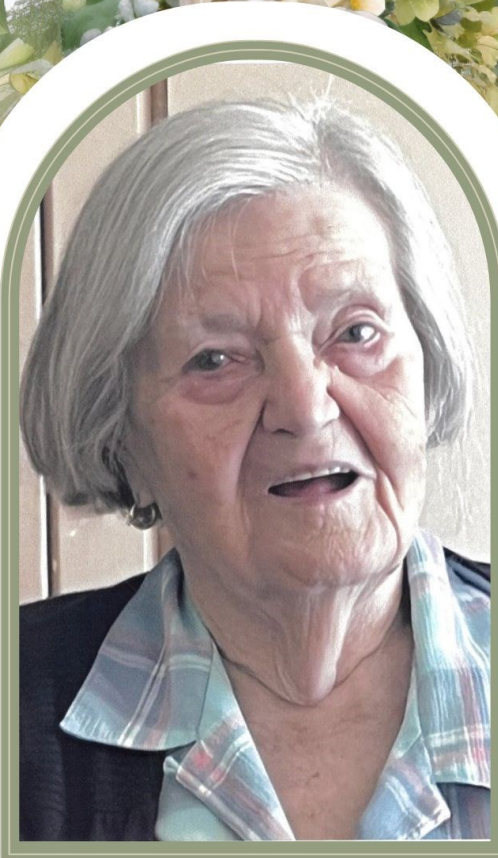
You prepare a table before me
