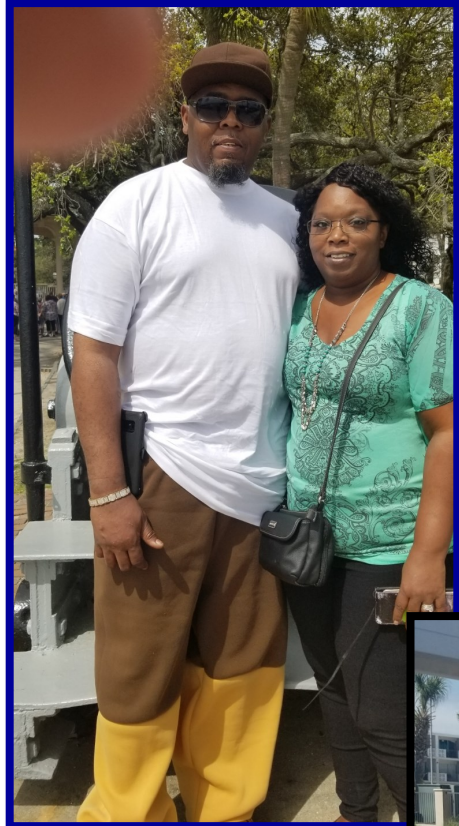


To My Husband

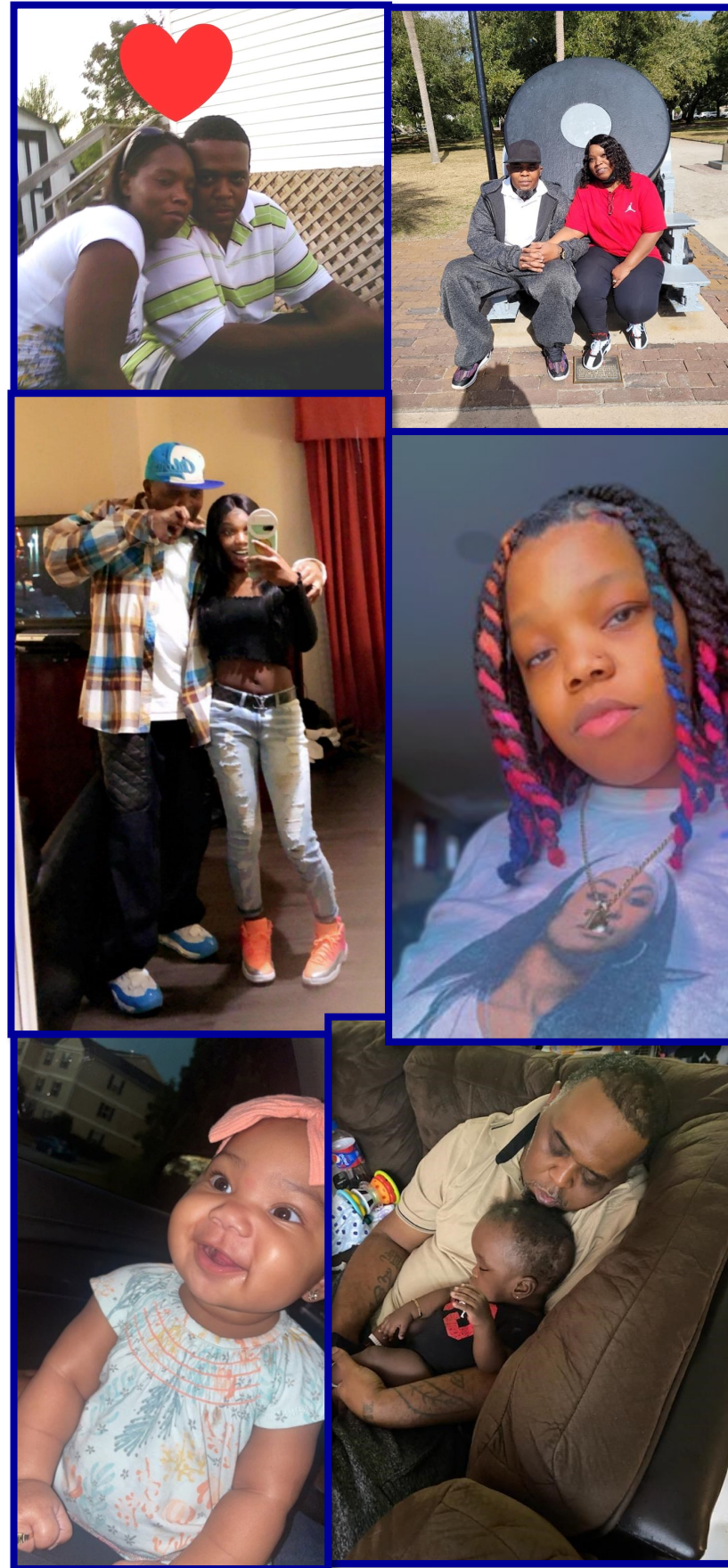
