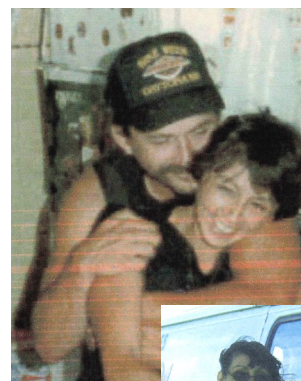


IF I KNEW
