The child needs to know:

– personal data: surname, name, patronymic, age and home address;

– information about parents: name and where you work;

– by heart a few poems, riddles;

– the contents of several fairy tales;

– the names of the months and seasons;

– the concept of "wild and domestic animals";

– some geometric shapes:

– the concept of "higher, lower, farther, closer, left, right";

– the concept of "thin, thick, smooth, curve, winding, wide, narrow";

– all colors of the rainbow;

– numbers.

The child should be able to:

– paint the right scene objects and pictures;

– answer the question in full sentence, not one word;

– to count to 10 and back;

– use of scissors;

– to focus on a sheet of paper;

– finding the differences and similarities of objects;

– to keep in order the workplace or briefcase;

– to independently dress and undress;

– chat, make friends, compromise.

Tips for parents

Teach your child from the age of 2-3 years of perseverance and patience.

Improve attention and interest to the class.

Read more fairy tales aloud. Ask questions after you have heard: "Who do you like or dislike about the story?", "Why?".

Learn the poems by heart. Improve memory.

Develop it baby in the game. Learn to describe the subject, which he.

Learn to communicate with peers and adults.

Develop fine motor skills: modeling in clay, carving and applique, the collection of mosaics, drawing and painting.

Learn to play games: desktop and mobile.

Praise your child for every small victory and accomplishment. Support the failures. Shouting and punishment for failure will forever discourage the child's desire to learn.

Never compare your child with other children. You need to be sure that it is best for parents.

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
