This year this bulletin space will be filled with materials drawn from a book written by Elmer Towns, Dean Emeritus of the School of Religion and Theological Seminary at Liberty University in Lynchburg, VA. It is entitled "I Am Jesus: Let's Change the World."

"A great famine...so the believers in Antioch decided to send relief... everyone giving as much as they could." (Acts 11:28, 29, NLT)

When a church is ministering to the poor, needy and helpless, that is Me showing My love through My church. It may be the hands of men and women in the church, but it is My hands. My church should never allow people to starve; it should give to demonstrate My love. Then they will listen to the gospel that will save them. You must think both physical and spiritual needs. You cannot minister one without the other. Look at My example while on Earth. I ministered to people whether or not they were My followers. And many began following Me because of "love in action."

No church can do all things to help all people at all times. But begin at home; minister to those in your family then those in your neighborhood. But remember, it is not giving money, or food, or physical healing. It is about your relationship to Me. Let My compassion flow through you.
