there are other eyes watching her coming, and other voices to take the glad shout, "Here she comes!" and such is dying.



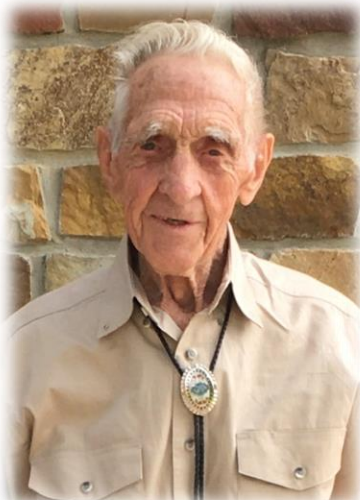
