Duane Lawrence Mogck was born on November 17, 1934, to G. Adolph and Lillian (Schlechter) Mogck on the family farm near Olivet, SD. Duane was baptized and confirmed in the Congregational faith in rural churches near Kaylor and Parkston, SD. He graduated from Tripp High School in 1952 and attended SDSU in Brookings, SD, where he ran track and studied agriculture. Duane left college early to return home and begin farming.

On June 9, 1957, Duane was united in marriage to Leona J. Walter. They spent a lifetime farming together near Olivet, SD. After retiring in 1989, they moved to Scotland, SD. Duane and Leona were members of the Scotland Community Church. Duane's love was farming and raising Angus cattle. He enjoyed traveling to different Angus sales, delivering bulls and spending time visiting with his customers. He was a member of the SD Angus Association, the American Angus Association, Rotary Club, a founding member of the Kaylor 4-H Club and actively involved with many church boards and committees, as well as community and business projects.

As a father and grandfather, he loved being involved with his sons and grandchildren,

whether it was working with them on the farm or cheering them on at all their school and sports events and then blessed to get to do it all over again with some of his great-grandchildren.

Duane went to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on November 25, 2024, at the age of 90.
