

# **TOURS & RENTALS: ITEMS TO BRING AND WHAT TO WEAR**

## **KAYAKING AND PADDLEBOARDING**

#### WARM WEATHER

-Sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat—protect yourself from the SC sun!

-Camera—COA will provide a dry bag for storing all electronics.

-Shoes that can get wet—oysters are sharp, so keep your feet protected!

-Cool clothing such as a swimsuit or activewear—synthetic material that dries quickly works well.

-1-2 bottles of water per person—please stay hydrated!

### **COLD WEATHER**

-Sunglasses and a hat—even in cold weather, the sun is bright on the water!

-Camera—COA will provide a dry bag for storing all electronics.

-Shoes that can get wet (old tennis shoes work well)—oysters are sharp, so keep your feet protected!

-Warm clothing such as long sleeves and pants—synthetic material that dries quickly works well.

-A light rain jacket—this helps keep the upper body dry and warm.

-At least 1 bottle of water per person—please stay hydrated!

\*Please Note: All <u>rentals</u> are required to bring a cell phone for emergency purposes. COA will provide a dry bag for storing all electronics.

## **BOAT CHARTERS**

### WARM WEATHER

-Sunscreen, sunglasses, and a hat—protect yourself from the SC sun!

-Camera—be ready to snap photos and videos of dolphins!

-Cool clothing—consider a light jacket as it can be somewhat cooler on the water, especially during the evening tours.

-1-2 bottles of water per person—please stay hydrated!

-Feel free to bring a small cooler with drinks and snacks! Alcohol is fine; however, we ask that you limit the amount of glass that you bring and <u>REFRAIN FROM BRINGING GLASS BEER BOTTLES</u> (i.e. use cans instead). Please drink responsibility and remember these are family friendly tours.

-For the Morris Island Charter, a small bag (preferably not plastic) for collecting seashells and other beach finds!

## COLD WEATHER

-Sunglasses and a hat—even in cold weather, the sun is bright on the water!

-Camera—be ready to snap photos and videos of dolphins!

-Warm clothing—please keep in mind that it typically feels around 10 degrees colder on the water riding in a boat than it does standing on the shore. We encourage you to bring extra jackets, scarves, hats, gloves, long underwear, blankets, and anything else you think you may need to stay warm!

-At least 1 bottle of water per person—please stay hydrated!

-Feel free to bring a small cooler with drinks and snacks! Alcohol is fine; however, we ask that you limit the amount of glass that you bring and <u>REFRAIN FROM BRINGING GLASS BEER BOTTLES</u> (i.e. use cans instead). Please drink responsibility and remember these are family friendly tours.
