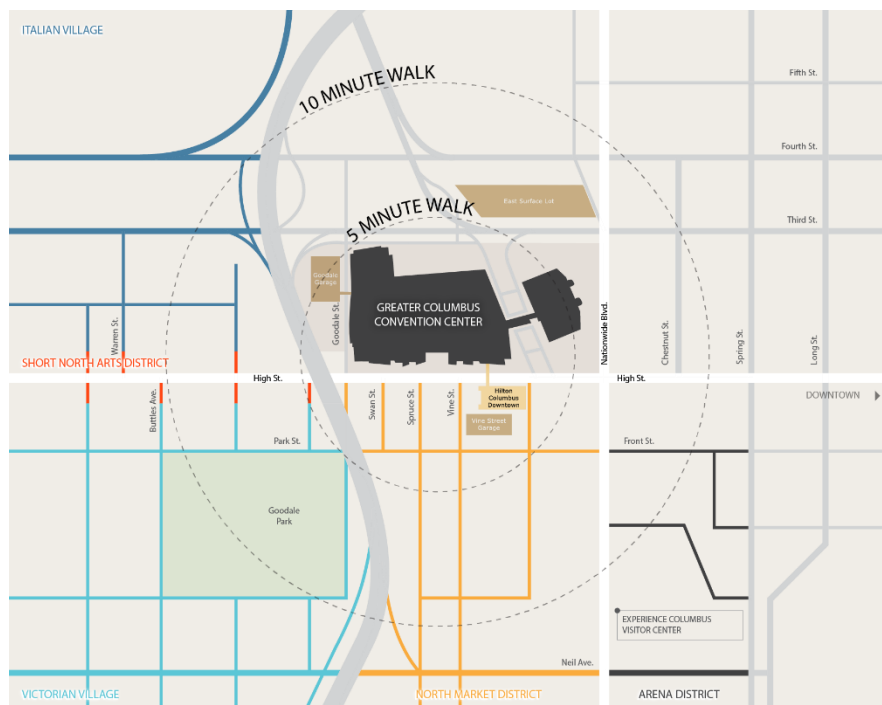

Parking is available via garage and surface parking lots. Parking is \$8-\$10 per entry. Overnight parking is not permitted.

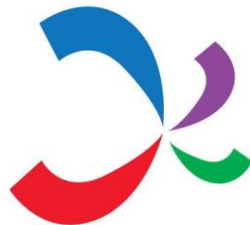

Your opinion on this year's Proposals and other Agenda Items pertaining to the governance of NAGVA is very important to the Members of the Board of Directors, and this is your opportunity to make your opinions heard and to gain a better understanding why these proposals are enacted or rejected by the Membership.

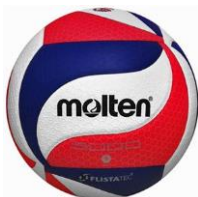

Remember to bring your own whistles. Failure to follow the rules may result in team penalties. Teams that do not have certified referees and scorekeepers will pay \$30 per position / per match.

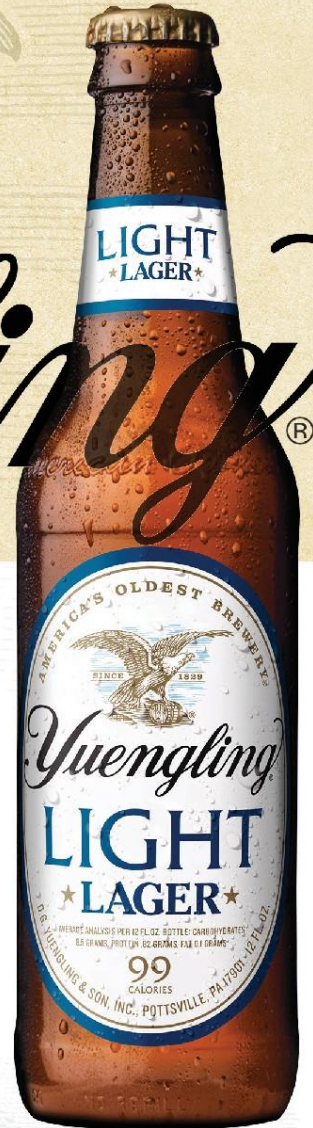

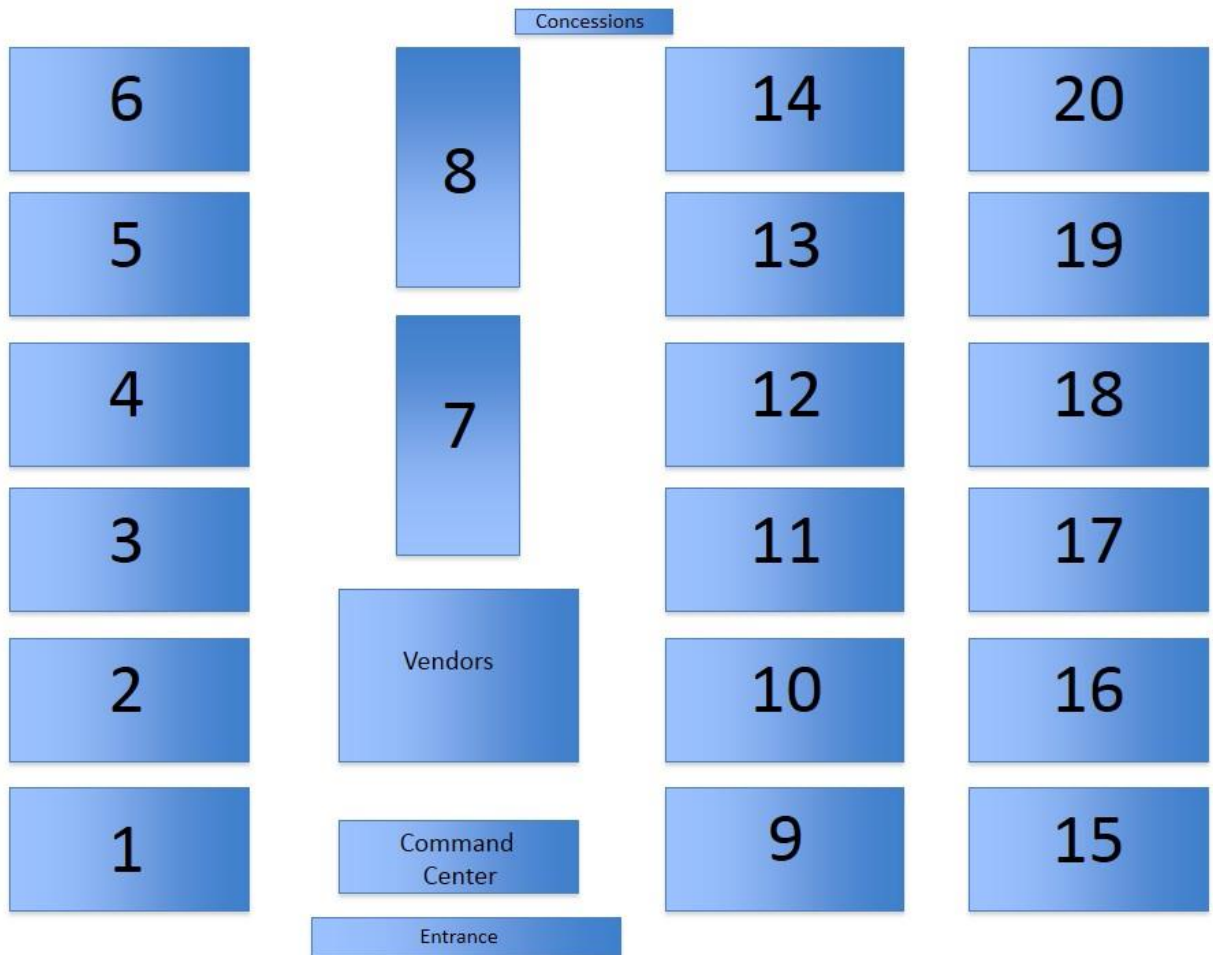

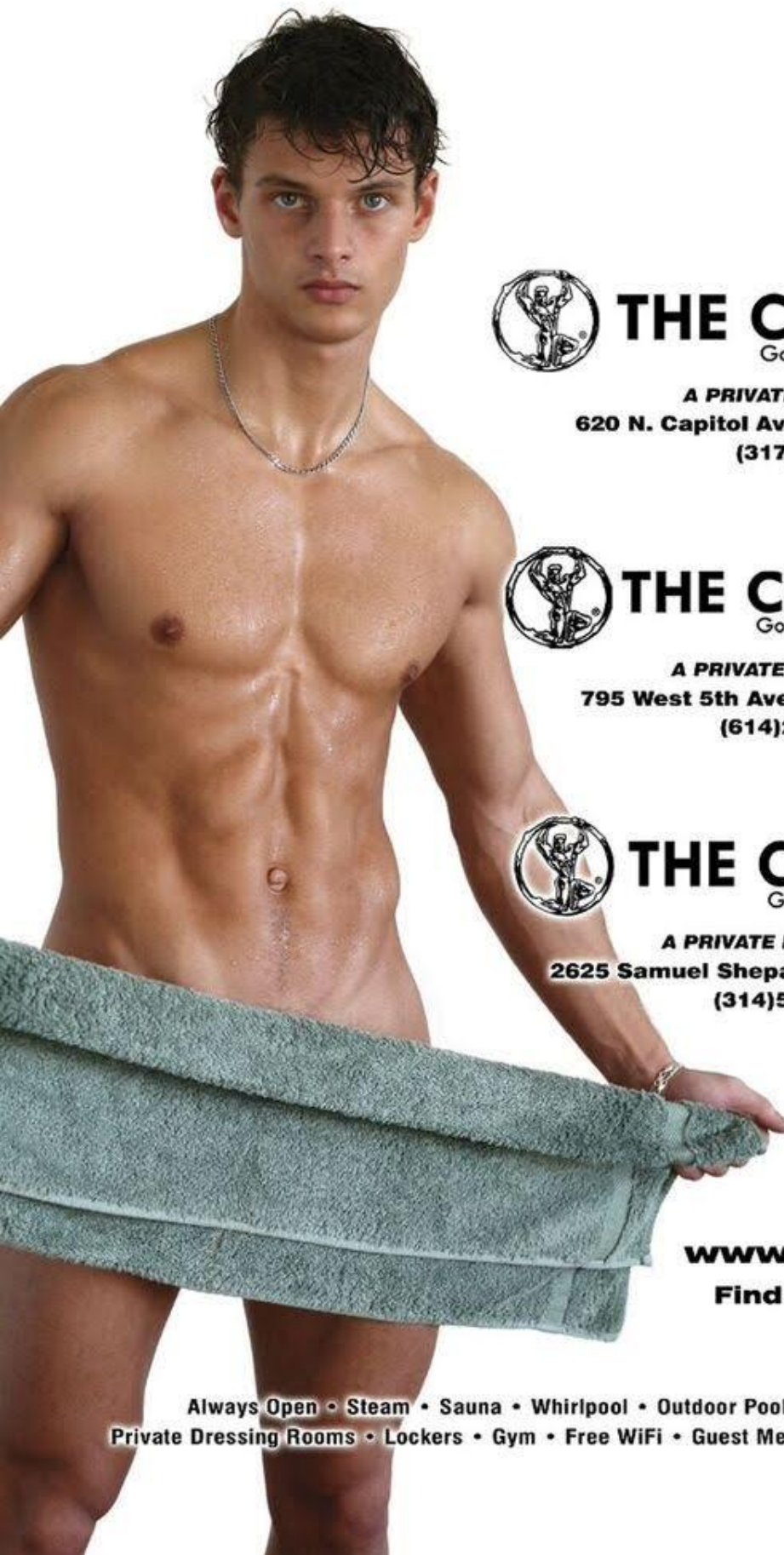
