Lunch money. During the communist era in Romania, a Christian teacher felt called by God to teach in a government-run school. Teaching in the all-boys boarding academy was not easy for her. She often tried talking to the students about Jesus but was unsuccessful.

The teacher prayed that God would show her how she could be a good witness. She noticed that the students' state-provided school lunches were always less than teenage boys needed to eat. She was impressed to save a little money every month in a special jar. When she heard of a hungry student, she would empty the jar, buy food, and feed the student.

Soon students started talking about the teacher and the lunches she provided. She rented a small house next to the school and students would often walk to her house for food during recess. Feeding hungry students became her ministry.

Was it successful? Three of the students she fed started listening to her stories about Jesus. Then they started reading the Bible and taking Bible studies. Eventually two of them were baptized. I would call that a success!
