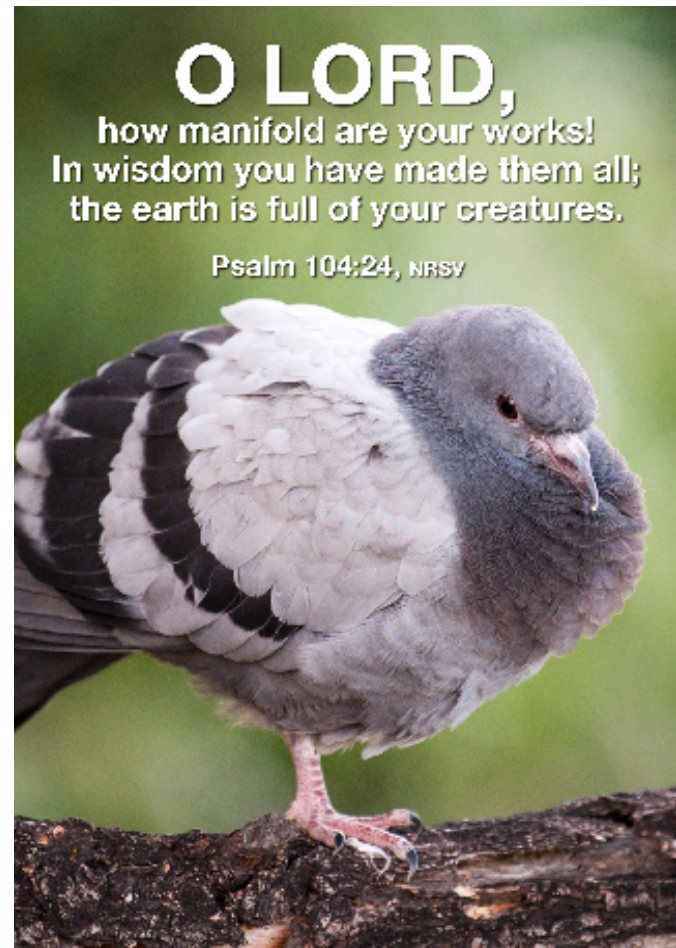

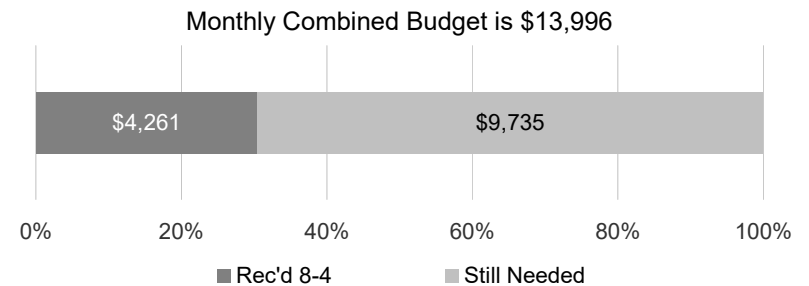
Fellowship Lunches have been cancelled for the rest of August, including today, as we review the structure and impact of this ministry. Watch for future updates.
