Terrell was educated at Ruskin High School in the Hickman Mills School District

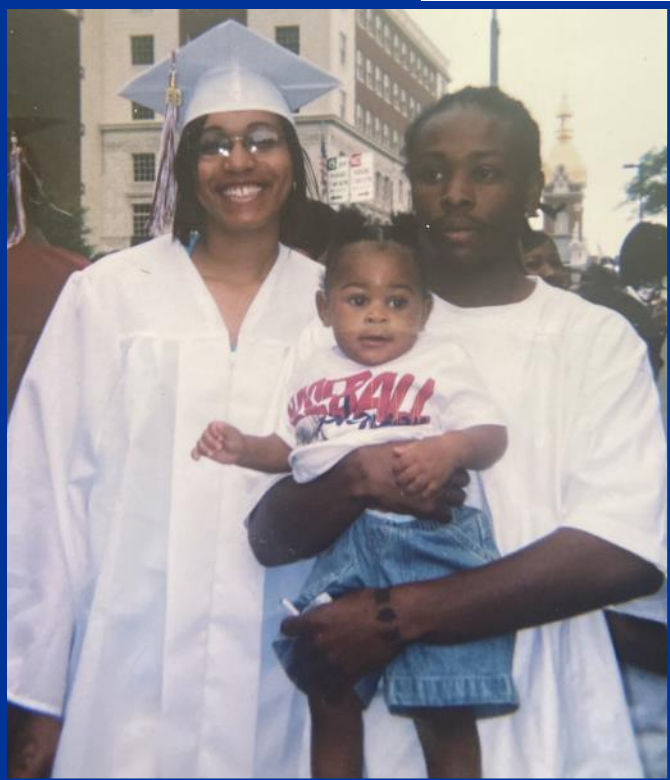
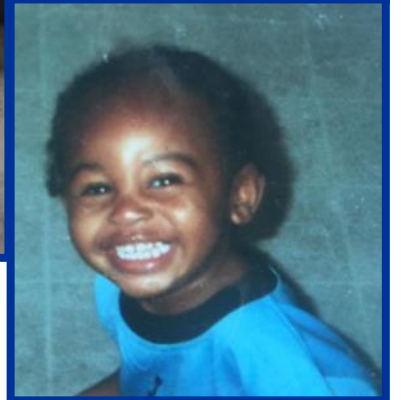
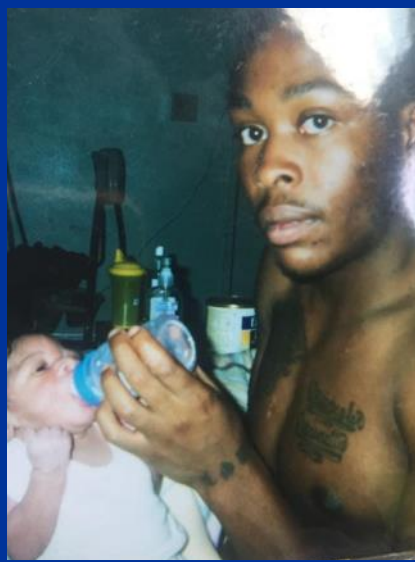
Terrell worked at All Purpose LLC.

Terrell was recruited by the head coaches at Ruskin High School



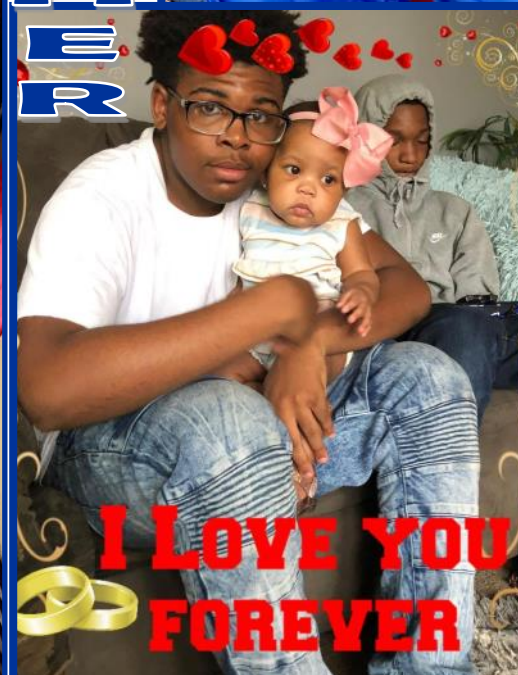
