the day God called you home.*

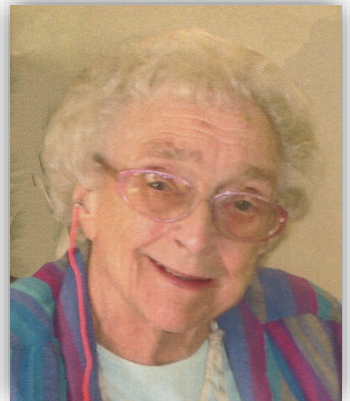
