Luke 10 vs 38-42 is the story of Mary and Martha and their different reactions to Jesus' visit. It teaches us an important truth that often we can get tied up in all the business and 'doing' of our daily lives that we fail to prioritise what should be most important, which is spending time to listen to Jesus and getting to know Him better.
