Thoughts From Today's Sermon

The apostle John ends his gospel by stating that Christ performed countless miracles, most of which if written the whole world could not contain those scrolls. In light of that, one marvels at the few miracles that were recorded. But we are certainly amazed at the one miracle that the Holy Spirit chose to be included in all four gospels... that of the feeding of the five thousand. There are other incidents (not miracles) in Christ's life that are also mentioned in all the gospels: His baptism, denial, trial, crucifixion and resurrection. The feeding of the five thousand certainly stands out and we should expect something special from this story. This morning we will review this glowing miracle and allow God's Spirit to make it profitable for us, for reproof, for correction, and for instruction in righteousness (See 2 Timothy 3:16).
