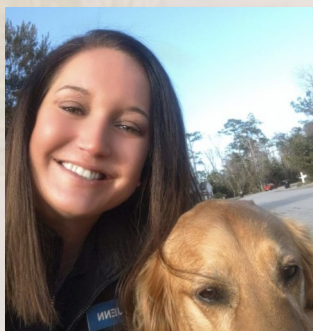
Jennifer was born October 23, 1980, in Wilmington, NC, where she grew up and attended New Hanover County Schools.
