Telenursing is moving forward at the West Coast University, Ontario campus! We are excited for our nursing students and we need your help! Telenursing is for everyone and can be a great way to learn more about your health. So, this is a great way to show our support for our future nurses during a challenging time!

What is Telenursing?

West Coast University has launched a telenursing program with a Registered Nurse who is a Nursing Professor educating nursing students. The purpose of telenursing is to support your health remotely and allows our nursing students to learn from the experience. Since many are sheltering at home during the COVID-19 Pandemic, telenursing can be beneficial since it is conducted remotely by phone. The WCU Telenursing program is a free service to the community and an opportunity for us to give back!

What should I expect on a Telenursing call?

Initially, you will be contacted to schedule a time for a telenursing appt. At your appt time, a WCU nursing professor and students will contact you by phone to discuss any health topics of interest or existing health conditions you might want to learn about.

As the nursing students and professor learn about you, they may ask if they can schedule a follow up appt to share additional health education resources with you. If you are interested, you can schedule a follow up appt.
