

OBITUARY

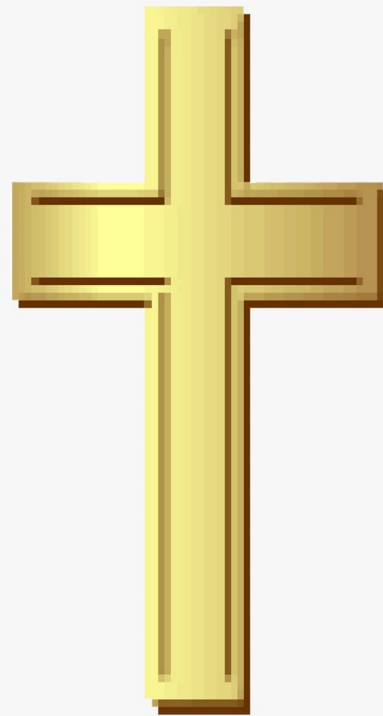
