

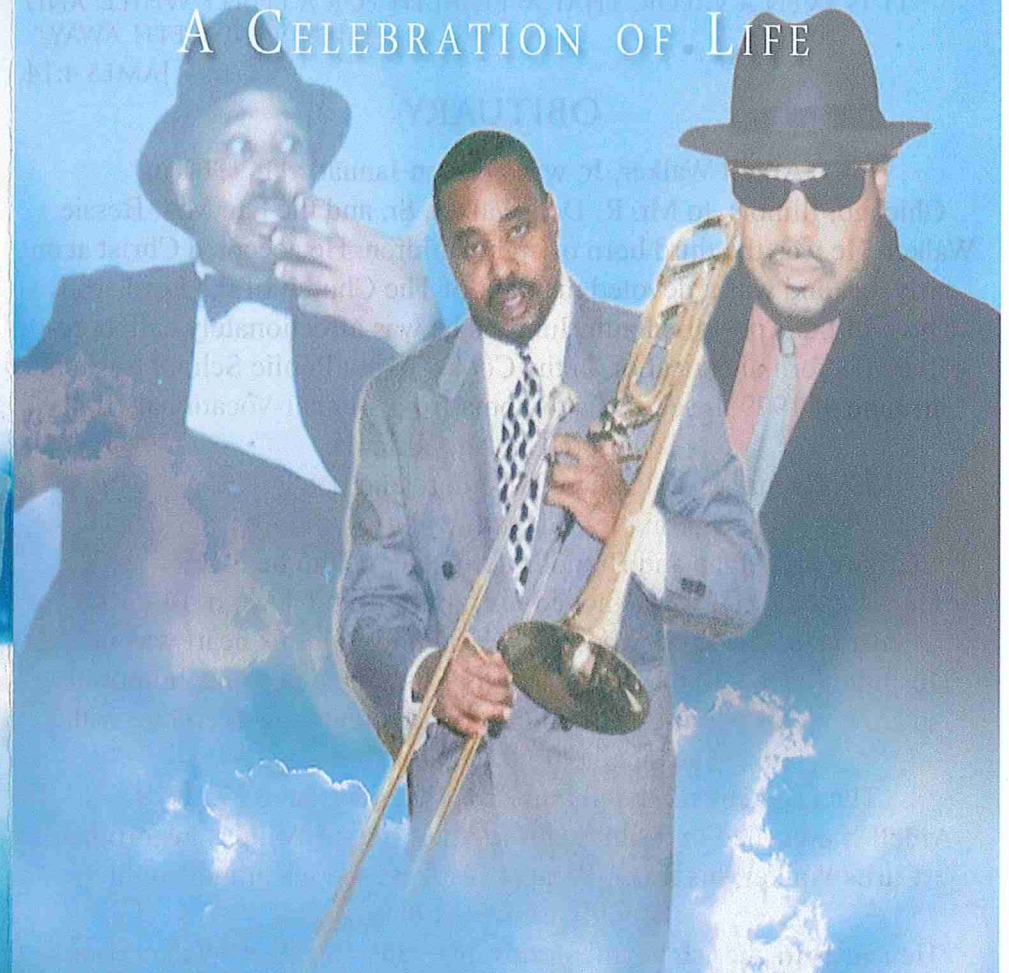
I'M FREE
